WHY NOT BECOME ONE OF OUR AMBASSADORS

Recycling is very important to us. Thanks to our We Need That! directory being so popular and people encouraging their friends and family to save items, we decided that we would look for Recycling Ambassadors to help us spread the word in Poole and Bournemouth and even further.

So what is a Recycling Ambassador?

A Recycling Ambassador is someone with an interest in recycling who wants to encourage others to recycle. This could involve them simply encouraging their close friends, family or neighbours to get involved in recycling. Or if they wanted more involvement, they could attend meetings of local groups to speak about local recycling initiatives.

Examples:






